


Fig. 1 Sniffer line SL200 in different versions




Fig. 2 Sniffer line SL200

Caution

To avoid damage switch off the leak detector at the mains before mounting the sniffer line.

- Connect the sniffer line SL200 with the flange KF25 to the inlet port of the leak detector.
- Then connect the 8-pin plug of the sniffer line SL200 with the built-in plug "Option" of the leak detector.

Now the sniffer line is ready to work.

5 Maintenance

Sniffer probe clogged

Clogging of the sniffer probe may be due to:

- Clogging of capillary filter: refer to Chapter 5.1
- Clogging of sinter filter: refer to Chapter 5.2
- Cloggin of sniffer probe capillary \rightarrow replace sniffer tip
- Damage of sniffer tip \rightarrow replace sniffer tip
- Clogging / damage of sniffer line \rightarrow replace sniffer tip




Fig. 4 Sniffer tip



5.1 Replacing the felt discs or the capillary filter

- · Switch the leak detector off or disconnect the sniffer line.
- Remove dirty felt discs by means of tweezers and replace them.
 or
- unscrew capillary filter and replace it.
 (If using the metallic version, do not forget the seal.)

5.2 Checking / replacing the sinter filter


- · Switch the leak detector off or disconnect the sniffer line.
- · Remove the two Phillips screws.
- · Remove the sinter filter with the seal.
- · Visually check the filter for contamination:



not / only slightly contaminated

Continue to use the sinter filter together with the seal.








Fig. 11 Declaration of contamination
